Friendship Connection by SEPTA

Friendship Connection is an avenue for our children to potentially make a friend within the SEPTA organization. By completing a quick checklist of interests of your child, SEPTA will try to match your child with another child close in age with similar interests. The information on the checklist will remain confidential and will only be shared with a potential match. SEPTA can not guarantee a match or can not guarantee that the friendship will work out. Friendship Connection is an attempt to assist children who may possess social awkwardness or shyness. The goal is to facilitate meeting a new friend. If SEPTA believes that there is an appropriate match, each person will be contacted by SEPTA, via email and the exchange of information (i.e. telephone number, email address, etc) will take place. Afterwards, it will be up to the two parents to decide to move forward. SEPTA's job at that point will be complete.
